Subject: Wireless Service Providers – 911 E2 Connection

As all Wireless Carriers are moving forward with plans to meet Federal Communications Commission (FCC) mandates to deliver 911 Phase II data this year, BellSouth would like to take this opportunity to provide the industry an update on where BellSouth is in assisting your company with its efforts.

BellSouth is finalizing its plans that will enable all Wireless Carriers to access the 911 Automatic Location Identification (ALI) databases and your company's assistance is needed as BellSouth moves forward. While there were initially some concerns regarding BellSouth's ability to utilize an E2 interface, after further review, BellSouth now believes the E2 is a logical interface between ALI and Wireless Carriers' facilities.

In providing access to its 911 database, BellSouth has been working with Intrado, Inc., to develop interfaces to the database that will enable the Phase II data to be deposited. Wireless Carriers need to advise BellSouth of the preferred method of interfacing with the BellSouth ALI databases.

If your company plans to use a third party vendor in connecting to the database, then BellSouth needs to know who that will be in order to negotiate your company's preferred interface. If your company plans to use its own interface, please contact BellSouth to begin defining requirements.
