Subject: CLECs – Update to the BellSouth Local Exchange Navigation System (LENS) User Guide, ENCORE Release 11.0 - Summary of Changes

This is to advise that the LENS User Guide is being re-issued to incorporate the following changes:

- <u>Mechanized Resale Coin Service</u>
 LENS will allow requests for Resale Coin service to be submitted electronically.
- <u>Mechanized Unbundled Network Element-Platform (UNE-P) Coin Service</u> LENS will allow requests for UNE-P Coin service to be submitted electronically.
- <u>Outside Moves (Activity Type T)</u> Local Service Requests (LSR) can now be submitted for REQTYP E and M Outside Moves (including requests between Revenue Accounting Offices for residential lines).
- <u>Mechanization of Unbundled Copper Loop (UCL) Non-Designed</u> LENS will allow requests for 2-wire Unbundled Copper Loop to be submitted electronically.
- View LSR

LSR/Order information can be viewed on a newly designed View LSR/Order Information screen. This screen will retain previously entered search criteria when the CLEC returns to it.

The updated statements are effective with the implementation of ENCORE Release 11.0 on December 29, 2002.

The updated LENS Users Guide will be available on November 25, 2002. It is recommended that a copy of this letter be placed in your company's current version of the LENS Users Guide until the changes are incorporated in the next update of the LENS Users Guide.
