REVISED - Use of Remarks Field on the Access Service Request to Order Channel Services Payment Plan (Originally posted on March 4, 2003)

This is to advise that a Remarks (RMKS) entry is required on the Access Service Request (ASR) to provide Channel Services Payment Plan (CSPP) contract information when ordering a circuit that is riding a higher-level service. In this situation, the higher level circuit is billed under a Transport Payment Plan (TPP) contract and the lower level circuit is billed under a CSPP contract. The Variable Term Agreement (VTA) field on the ASR must be populated with the TPP contract information. Failure to include the CSPP contract information in the RMKS section of the ASR will result in the circuit being billed at a month-to-month recurring rate rather than the CSPP contract rate.

Following is an example of a valid entry for use in the RMKS section of the ASR for the CSPP contract information:

RMKS: "TPP=A36, CSPP=136"

In this example, the higher-level service is contracted under a TPP Standard Payment Option, represented by letter "A" for 36 months and the lower level circuit is contracted for a CSPP Standard Payment Option, represented by numeric "1" for 36 months.
