Subject: CLECs – REVISED: Use of BellSouth Uniform Service Order Code (USOC) CREX7 with

Unbundled Network Elements-Platform (UNE-P) (Originally posted on April 30, 2003)

This is to advise that currently, the customized code restriction USOC, CREX7, should be used only in association with the following UNE-P USOCs:

State	USOCs
Alabama	UEPAR, UEPWA
Florida	UEPA1, UEPA8
Kentucky	UEPRM, UEPWE
Louisiana	UEPAS, UEPWG
Mississippi	UEPAT, UEPWJ
Tennessee	UEPAQ, UEPWN

If CREX7 USOC is ordered with a UNE-P USOC other than one listed above, the order will be returned to the CLEC for clarification. BellSouth is in the process of providing CREX7 with UNE-P in the states of Georgia and North Carolina. Further information regarding the delivery date of such capability will be provided in subsequent correspondence.

The CREX7 USOC applies to residential end users and allows 1+ IntraLATA dialing but will block the following:

Operator Assisted Calls (0, 0+, 00, 101XXXX+0+), Directory Assistance (411, 1+411, 0+411, 1+555-1212, 1+NPA+555-1212), N11 Services (211, 311, 511, 611, 711, 811), Pay-Per-Call (976, 1+976, 101XXXX+1+900), Long Distance (DDD 1+Interlata, 101XXXX+1+), and International Calling (IDDD 01+, IDDD 011+)

BellSouth will update the UNE-P CLEC Information Package on the BellSouth Interconnection Services' Web site and the Local Ordering Handbook to reflect this condition. Until such time, this notice shall supersede any conflicting documentation regarding the use of CREX7 with UNE-P.
