DS1 Enhanced Extended Links (EEL) in Kentucky

This is to advise that on June 14, 2004, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (KPSC) in case No. 2001-105 required BellSouth to implement the Georgia Performance Plan - Service Quality Measures (SQM) and Self-Effectuating Enforcement Mechanisms (SEEMs) plans in Kentucky. As a result of this requirement, beginning August 1, 2004, the standard interval for DSL EELs in Kentucky will change to the following:

The change will be reflected in the update of the Local Ordering Handbook (LOH) Version 16.0c for Telecommunications Industry Forum 9 (TCIF 9) and EDI Local Mechanization Specification 6 (ELMS 6) for Release 16.0 as well as the LOH Version 17.0a for TCIF 9 and ELMS 6 for Release 17.0, scheduled to be posted on September 17, 2004.
