Subject: CLECs – (Documentation/Guides) – Implementation of the Manual Migration to Channelized Transport CLEC Information Package

This is to advise that on July 30, 2004, BellSouth will post the Manual Migration to Channelized Transport CLEC Information Package.

This package describes in detail how a requesting CLEC may manually migrate existing non-complex Unbundled Network Element (UNE) loops connected to BellSouth switches (move the serving wire center end) as well as how a CLEC may migrate standalone UNE loops to higher bandwidth channelized UNE transport connected to a collocation in another serving wire center. This process will require the CLEC to have in place a UNE interoffice facility with one end point in the serving wire center from which the loop is served and another end point in a collocation arrangement. The CLEC will be required to certify that the resulting combined circuit (UNE loop and UNE dedicated transport) meets any applicable Enhanced Extended Link (EEL) eligibility requirements specified in its Interconnection Agreement. Individual resale, retail, UNE-P or UNE-L loops may be migrated. The manual bulk migration process that is utilized for UNE-P migrations is also available for migrations of multiple resale, UNE-P, and UNE-L loop accounts.
