Subject: ATM and Frame Relay Customers – (Billing and Tariff) - Tariff Changes for ATM and

Frame Relay Services

This is to advise that BellSouth Interconnection Services Marketing is announcing two upcoming changes to the BellSouth Tariff FCC No. 1 for ATM and Frame Relay services.

The first change will be a modification to the Fast Packet Services Payment Plan (FSPP). This plan provides customers discounted rates on ATM and Frame Relay circuits that are placed under an FSPP term plan. The tariff filing will provide customers with the ability to upgrade their fast packet connections under an FSPP plan to higher speeds without incurring an FSPP termination liability charge on the lower-speed connection. This tariff change will enable customers to more easily migrate to higher speed connections.

The second tariff change will provide customers with the ability to place Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) traffic on Inverse Multiplexing on ATM (IMA) connections. In addition, this change will also provide customers with the ability to use IMA connections (ATM speeds between DS1 and DS3) to aggregate DSL traffic. By using IMA connections, customers can economically grow from DS1 to DS3 speeds based on their bandwidth needs.

These tariff changes will be filed on October 19, 2004, with an effective date of November 3, 2004.
