Subject: CLECs – (Maintenance & Repair and Provisioning) - Force Majeure Event for Mississippi Operations – Self-Effecting Enforcement Mechanisms (SEEM) Payments and Service Level Contract Penalties for September 2004

This is to advise that due to the recent hurricanes in Mississippi, BellSouth posted a notice to the Performance Measurement Analysis Platform (PMAP) Web site related to the effect of the hurricanes on September 2004 SEEM and SLC Payments in Mississippi. As stated in that notice, and as described in BellSouth's letter filed with the Mississippi Public Service Commission (PSC) on October 1, 2004, Hurricane Ivan constituted a Force Majeure event that affected BellSouth's operations in Mississippi. In accordance with paragraph 4.5.3 of the Mississippi SEEM Administrative Plan and paragraph 17 of the Service Level Contract, BellSouth is not obligated to pay remedies when a Force Majeure event results in performance noncompliance.

Hurricane Ivan affected BellSouth's Provisioning and Maintenance and Repair (M&R) operations in those wire centers specified in the October 1, 2004 letter to the PSC. A list of those wire centers is attached to this notice. Thus, BellSouth has excluded data from the affected wire centers for the period of September 15, 2004, through September 30, 2004, in calculating the submetrics upon which Provisioning and M&R remedies will be paid for the month of August. Due to the additional time needed to account for the impact of this Force Majeure event, BellSouth was unable to calculate by November 15, 2004, accurate remedies for Provisioning and M&R submetrics for the period of September 15, 2004, to September 30, 2004, for the wire centers affected by Hurricane Ivan. The revised Parity Analysis and Remedy Information System (PARIS) reports and payments for September will be reflected with the October SEEM reports scheduled to be posted and paid on December 15, 2004. Remedies for submetrics in all other measurement domains were not affected by or adjusted for this Force Majeure event.
