Subject: Facility-Based CLECs – (Collocation/Tariff) – Additional Physical and Virtual Access Cross Connect Service Offerings Now Available

This is to advise that effective December 17, 2004, Physical and Virtual Access Cross Connect Service Offerings in the BellSouth Tariff FCC No. 1 have been updated to include Asymmetrical Digital Subscriber Line (ADSL), End User Aggregation Service and Metro Ethernet Service as eligible services that may be cross-connected to a collocation space. The Physical Access Cross Connect Service and Virtual Access Cross Connect Service offerings are contained in Section 13, Additional Engineering, Additional Labor and Miscellaneous Services, and are described below.

Section 13.3.23 Physical Access Cross Connect Service Section 13.3.24 Virtual Access Cross Connect Service

These cross connects are used to provide a one-to-one dedicated transmission path between a switched or special access service offering or transport equipment located in a BellSouth Central Office (CO) and a carrier's physical or virtual collocation arrangement. These cross-connects must be ordered on the same Access Service Request (ASR) as the service being cross-connected to the collocation space.

A nonrecurring charge, as well as monthly recurring charges, will apply based on the level of service requested (DS1, DS3, fiber-based services or Catagory-5 cable-based services). These charges will be assessed based upon the type of service (switched access or special access) being connected to the collocation space and will be applied on a per cross connect basis. The specific BellSouth access services that may be connected to a carrier's physical collocation space for each service level are listed in the tariff. The applicable access cross connect rates will apply when a carrier orders services from the BellSouth FCC Tariff that will terminate into a collocation arrangement, whether the arrangement belongs to the ordering carrier or to another collocated carrier.
