Subject: CLECs – (Maintenance & Repair and Provisioning) - Force Majeure Event for Florida Operations – Self-Effecting Enforcement Mechanisms (SEEM) Payments and Service Level Contract (SLC) Penalties for November 2004

This is to advise that due to the recent hurricanes in Florida, BellSouth posted a notice to the Performance Measurement Analysis Platform (PMAP) Web site related to the effect of the hurricanes on November 2004 SEEM and SLC Payments in Florida. As stated in that notice, and as described in BellSouth's letter filed with the Florida Public Service Commission (PSC) on November 15, 2004, Hurricanes Charley, Frances, Ivan, and Jeanne constituted a Force Majeure event that continued to affect BellSouth's operations in Florida through November 2004. In accordance with paragraph 4.5.4 of the Florida SEEM Administrative Plan and paragraph 17 of the SLC, BellSouth is not obligated to pay remedies when a Force Majeure event results in performance noncompliance.

These hurricanes affected BellSouth's Provisioning and Maintenance and Repair (M&R) operations in all wire centers in Florida from November 1, 2004 through November 15, 2004, and continued for the remainder of November in a limited area as specified in the November 15, 2004 letter to the PSC. A list of those wire centers affected for the entire month of November 2004 is attached to this notice. Thus, BellSouth has excluded data from all Florida wire centers for the period of November 1, 2004, through November 15, 2004, and for the specific wire centers in the attached list for the remainder of the month of November, in calculating the submetrics upon which Provisioning and M&R remedies will be paid for the month of November. Remedies for submetrics in all other measurement domains were not affected by or adjusted for this Force Majeure event.
