Subject: All Telecommunications Carriers – (E-911) - Conversion of Signaling for Emergency

Service (ES) Trunks from Multi Frequency (MF) to Common Channel Signaling

System 7 (CCS7) in the State of South Carolina

This is to advise that based on the need to provide and maintain the reliability and integrity of E-911 service and as communications technologies and the regulatory environment change, BellSouth now offers an additional industry standard signaling option for its E-911 service by supporting the use of Signaling System 7/Integrated Digital Network User Part (SS7/ISUP) for incoming E-911 calls.

BellSouth will begin the conversion of its South Carolina end office Emergency Service (ES) trunks from Multi Frequency (MF) to Common Channel Signaling System 7 (CCS7) starting February 15, 2005, with a target date for completion of December 31, 2005. No action will be required by the Telecommunications Carrier community with this signaling conversion.

Telecommunications Carriers interested in converting their signaling for E-911 ES trunks to CCS7 are invited to contact their BellSouth account team representative with any questions.
