in North Carolina

This is to advise that pursuant to the North Carolina Utilities Commission (NCUC) order in Docket P-55, SUB 1538, dated December 22, 2004, carriers will be allowed to order the Local Service Freeze (LSF) feature in the state of North Carolina.

Change Control Process (CCP) Change Request (CR) 2131 is scheduled for implementation in the upcoming 18.0 production release the weekend of March 6, 2005, that will allow carriers to order the LSF feature in the state of North Carolina.

The attached changes will be reflected in the next update of the Telecommunications Industry Forum 9 (TCIF 9) and EDI Local Mechanization Specifications 6 (ELMS 6) production release of the Local Ordering Handbook (LOH), Version 18a scheduled to be posted Friday, March 4, 2005. ## LSCP - Local Service Provider Change Prohibited

## LSR Form/Screen, NA Section

18.0A (LSOG6 / ELMS6 map)

Updated: 01/03/05, CRB Issues included: None

#### **Definition:**

Identifies that the end user has requested the option of prohibiting the change of their current service provider or removing the option.

## **Definition Notes:**

NOTE 1: Invoking this option may require additional authorization or written permission.

NOTE 2: This field is used to freeze or remove the freeze from the entire account.

#### Valid Entries:

Entry Description

A Prohibit a change of current local service provider

B Remove the prohibition

## Valid Entry Notes:

NOTE 1: The valid entry of "B" is prohibited when the ACT is N.

NOTE 2: When the ACT is C and LSF is on the existing CSR  $\,$  the only valid entry in this field is "B" .

NOTE 3: When the ACT is V and LSF is not on the existing CSR the only valid entry in this field is "A".

NOTE 4: When the ACT is C and LSF is not on the existing CSR the only valid entry in this field is "A".

Note 5: The valid entry of A is prohibited when the end user state is Alabama.

## **Conditional Usage Notes:**

Note 1: Prohibited when the ACT is V and the migration is from a BellSouth Retail account and LSF (Local Service Freeze) is present on the existing CSR.

Note 2: Prohibited when the REQTYP is J.

Note 3: Prohibited when the REQTYP is F and the ACT is V, B, D S, L or Y.

Note 4: Prohibited when the REOTYP is A.

Note 5: Prohibited when the ACT is W.

Note 6: Prohibited when the REQTYP is E, and the 2nd character of TOS is H and the ACT is D.

Note 7: Prohibited when the REQTYP is E (Non-Complex) or REQTYP M (Non-Complex) and the ACT is D, S, B, L or Y.

Note 8: Prohibited when the REQTYP is N and the 2nd character of the TOS is J, and the ACT is D.

## **Business Rules**

Rule 1: Local Service Freeze (LSF) is valid in all states except Georgia and Alabama and North Carolina.

Rule 2: When the ACT = T and the existing account has LSF on the Customer Service Record (CSR) and the LSCP field is not populated on the LSR, the LSF will be transferred to the CSR at the new location.

LP Add Local Service Freeze (LSF) per local service provider request

## Valid Entry Notes:

Note 1: For REQTYPs A, positions 1 - 7 = any alpha character except I " or any numeric character except " 0 " (zero).

Note 2: For REQTYP E and M, LSF Valid Entries (Activity Types = N, C, T, V, P and O).

Note 3: The valid values of EU and LP are prohibited when the end user state is Alabama.

## Manual:

Note 3: When ordering a REQTYP A Unbundled Dark Fiber (UDF) as an Ordinarily Combined UNE Combination the only valid entry in the SPEC field is UDFCX.

Note 1: Required when ordering REQTYP A Unbundled Dark Fiber (UDF) as an Ordinarily Combined UNE Combination.

Rule 1: LSF valid in all states except Georgia and Alabama, and North Carolina.

Rule 2: For REQTYP 'A" the following table contains valid SPEC codes for EELs and NSC's service types.
