Subject: All Interconnection Services Customers – (Business/Operational Process) – Introduction of a New NXX in Kentucky Requires Changes to the Local Dialing Arrangements for the South Cunningham and South Fredonia Exchanges in Tennessee

On March 11, 2005, a new NXX of 412 will be introduced in the Oak Grove, Kentucky exchange in the existing 270 NPA. This new NXX will duplicate the 412 NXX code currently serving the Spencer Mill, Tennessee exchange, located in the 615 NPA. BellSouth's South Cunningham and South Fredonia exchanges, located in the 615 NPA, currently have local 7-digit dialing arrangements to both exchanges. Therefore, the introduction of the NPA/NXX 270-412 in the Oak Grove, Kentucky exchange will require some changes to the local dialing arrangements in South Cunningham and South Fredonia to ensure that customers can continue to call both exchanges.

Effective with the introduction of the new NPA/NXX 270-412, local calls originating in South Cunningham and South Fredonia exchange and terminating to the new NPA/NXX 270-412 code in Oak Grove, KY will be on a local 10-digit basis. The following NPA-NXX codes are affected by this change:

**Local calls originated from:**

South Cunningham 615-214  
South Fredonia 615-307

**Local Calls terminated to:**

Oak Grove, KY 270-412

This change will not apply to calls from South Cunningham or South Fredonia to the existing NPA-NXX codes in Oak Grove, Kentucky, and those calls will continue to be made on a local 7-digit basis. This change has no effect on any dialing arrangements for calls originated in Oak Grove, Kentucky. Finally, calls originated in either South Cunningham or South Fredonia to Oak Grove, KY will continue to be rated as local calls.
