Line Information Database (LIDB) GetData Query with 8 New Data Elements

This is to advise that on May 13, 2005, BellSouth will introduce 8 new data elements associated with customer telephone numbers in its Line Information Database (LIDB) GetData query. GetData query service is offered in Section 19 of the BellSouth Tariff FCC No. 1 to provide telecommunications service providers with access to LIDB subscriber line data that may be used for call processing, validation, billing and fraud prevention.

Listed below are the 8 new data elements that will be available in the LIDB GetData query:

- End User Billing Name and Address (BNA)
- o Toll Restriction Indicator
- o 900/976 Call Blocking Indicator
- o Customer Code
- Service Start Date
- Company Type
- o Primary Interexchange Carrier (PIC) Activation Date
- Local PIC (LPIC) Activation Date

These new data elements will be available in addition to the 3 existing data elements of Account Owner, Revenue Accounting Office and Billing Service Provider. The GetData query will provide access to one or more of these data fields in a single query with 272 octets of information limit in the response message.

GetData will query BellSouth end user data and, where authorized, other carriers' end user data. Common transport connectivity to the LIDB database is a prerequisite to ordering GetData over the Signaling System 7 (SS7) network.
