On September 2, 2005, BellSouth issued Carrier Notification Letter SN91085171 advising that BellSouth was invoking the Force Majeure provision of the agreement between BellSouth and your company, including, but not limited to, the Interconnection Agreements (including the Force Majeure provisions contained in BellSouth's Self-Effecting Enforcement Mechanism (SEEM) plans), Commercial Mobile Radio Services (CMRS) Agreements, Commercial Agreements and BellSouth tariffs for those areas affected by Hurricane Katrina.

This is to advise that, effective Tuesday, November 1, 2005, the Force Majeure condition resulting from Hurricane Katrina was eliminated in Alabama.
