On September 2, 2005, BellSouth issued Carrier Notification letter **SN91085171** advising that BellSouth was invoking the Force Majeure provision of the agreement between BellSouth and your company, including, but not limited to, the Interconnection Agreements (including the Force Majeure provisions contained in BellSouth's Self-Effecting Enforcement Mechanism (SEEM) plans), Commercial Mobile Radio Services (CMRS) Agreements, Commercial Agreements and BellSouth tariffs for those areas affected by Hurricane Katrina.

This is to advise that, effective Thursday, January 5, 2006, the statewide Force Majeure that was placed into effect in Louisiana due to Hurricane Katrina is lifted for certain portions of the state. Force Majeure **remains in effect** in several geographic areas until further notice. Attached are NPA/NXXs for the areas of Louisiana that **remain** under Force Majeure. BellSouth will continue to operate under Force Majeure in these geographic areas until further notice.
