Subject: All Interconnection Services Customers – (Billing, Tariff and Product /Service) –  
Enhancement to the BellSouth® Wavelength Dedicated Ring Service

This is to advise that, effective March 16, 2006, BellSouth will enhance the existing BellSouth® Wavelength Dedicated Ring service to include a single bay offering along with the current dual bay service. The single bay service will be provided in dedicated ring architecture. The system is capable of providing up to 16 wavelengths in each direction for a total capacity of 32 unprotected wavelengths. The customer must have a minimum of three system nodes located at the customer location and/or BellSouth Central Office (CO), however at least one node must be located in a BellSouth CO. The initial configuration requirement consists of a minimum of an 8 wavelength capacity with incremental increases of 8 wavelengths up to the total capacity of 16 wavelengths between any two nodes.

The single bay offering may be used to transport BellSouth Wavelength Dedicated Ring service, as described in the BellSouth Tariff FCC No. 1, Section 29.

Ordering and implementation may begin on the tariff effective date. The Carrier Access Billing System (CABS) will render billing in the same manner in which existing bills are rendered today. In addition, the CABS bill will reflect the appropriate Uniform Service Order Code (USOC) for the service ordered.
