Enhancements to the Wavelength Dedicated Ring Service

On March 14, 2007, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Southeast (AT&T) will enhance the BellSouth Tariff FCC No. 1, Section 29, to broaden the Wavelength service to allow a two-node Wavelength Dedicated Ring service. This service will no longer require a central office ring node but will provide a monitoring node location. This service will be available for both the single and dual bay configuration. The monitoring node location will not provide any customer service functions, but will allow AT&T to monitor the service provided on the Wavelength Dedicated Ring.

Ordering and implementation may begin on the tariff effective date. Carrier Access Billing System (CABS) bills will be rendered in the same manner that existing bills are rendered today. In addition, the CABS bill will reflect the appropriate Uniform Service Order Code (USOC) for the services ordered.
