Subject: Changes on the Local Exchange Navigation System

There will be three changes put into place on the Local Exchange Navigation System (LENS) by the beginning of business January 6, 1998. The changes are as follows:

1. The new NPA - Metro Atlanta will add a new NPA, 678. CLECs will soon be contacting customers with 678, and reserving 678 TNS. LENS will be ready to handle the new NPA.
2. The 100 TN per switch per CLEC limit will be removed. You can now reserve an unlimited number of TN's per switch. LENS still allows you to reserve six lines per request.
3. Complex CSR capability - You will now be able to move from a section of a CSR with no data into a section with data.
