Data Exchange For CLEC Interconnection With SWBT

The local and intraLATA toll intercompany compensation billing process and data exchange for switch-based CLECs and the Category 92 record process:

- Utilizes originating EU recordings. It is the responsibility of the originating company to create the category 92 records and provide them to the other LECs/CLECs on the call path.
- Is utilized for both intercompany compensation and for the settlement of alternately billed messages. Copies of the EU alternately billed messages are used to return revenues from the billing company to the originating (earning) company.
