

## AT&T California Conduit Mapping Protocol

Protocol for providing structure maps to entities that have reached structure access agreements with AT&T California for access to AT&T California conduit. Such entities are referred to herein as "Attaching Party."

1. Attaching Party must use the AT&T STRUCTURE ACCESS MAX GRADE/MAP REQUEST form to either:
  - a. Submit an application for structure access or facility records along with the advance payment;
  - Or
  - b. Specify an existing job, with sufficient advanced payments, that has been designated for the specific use of processing multiple structure map requests by the Attaching Party over a period not to exceed twelve months.
2. Attaching Party shall have a current, executed Non-Disclosure Agreement with AT&T California.
3. Attaching Party shall request maps by submitting a geographical depiction of starting and ending points, on a street map, for the potential attachment of its facilities to AT&T-owned or controlled conduit.
4. Individual requests shall not exceed 10,000 linear feet.
5. AT&T shall respond to requests within 10 business days.
6. The map product provided by AT&T may be either in electronic or paper form, as determined by the Attaching Party who shall bear the costs associated with creating and providing the product. The map will depict AT&T-owned or controlled manholes and conduit. Since the source of this data is AT&T's engineering records, the inclusion of any of these structures is limited to the extent that they exist on AT&T's engineering records. AT&T does not guarantee or warrant the accuracy of any information provided including, but not limited to, location, actual existence in the field, and ownership.

The protocols are intended to be in furtherance of carrying out the terms for structure access set forth in the applicable Structure Access or Interconnection Agreement, and shall be construed in light of the purpose of such agreements and applicable law.

Maps are the property of AT&T. AT&T's records are confidential and proprietary information not for use or disclosure outside the AT&T companies except under written agreement. The copying, scanning, or other reproduction of the maps and other information without prior written permission of AT&T is strictly prohibited. Attaching Party must destroy paper maps and delete and remove any electronic versions of maps from all systems on the earliest of the following: (1) within one year of receipt; (2) upon receiving permit to construct from AT&T; or (3) upon request by AT&T.
