Subject: CLECs – **REVISED**: Update Access Daily Usage File/Exchange Message Interface Record Format (originally released January 17, 2001)

In order to keep the Access Daily Usage File (ADUF) product Exchange Message Interface Record Format (EMI) compliant, BellSouth will implement the following changes to the ADUF product on or about May 5, 2001:

- Change ADUF headers/trailers from 202009/202010 to 202409/202410.
- Change ADUF international records from 1101XX to 1102XX.
- Change ADUF cancel records from Category 58 to Category 50.
- Change ADUF records terminating to DA (411, 1+411, 1+555-1212) from 110101 to **110132**.
