Subject: CLECs - Resale of Service to Wireless Carriers

In response to inquiries from CLECs who want to resell telecommunications services to wireless carriers, a new *CLEC Guide for Ordering Local Service for Resale to Wireless Carriers* has been posted on the BellSouth Interconnection Services' Web site:

This guide is intended for use by CLECs who plan to resell BellSouth products and services to licensed wireless service providers. Prior to reselling telecommunications services to wireless carriers, CLECs should be knowledgeable about the federal, state and local regulations for sale of these services.

Resale of telecommunications services to wireless carriers requires the same certification and contractual requirements as that of any other CLEC service. The CLEC must be certified by each state Commission where service is provided, have a current interconnection agreement with BellSouth, and have Q accounts set up prior to ordering service.

Wireless carriers are licensed by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC), state and local authorities to provide wireless service to end user customers. As the licenses are a legal requirement for the sale of wireless service, CLECs who are not also licensed wireless carriers may not provide wireless service directly to end users. CLECs who are also licensed as wireless carriers provide wireless service to end users as wireless carriers, not as CLECs, and do not receive CLEC discounts on those services.

Prior to setting up accounts and passing orders, wireless carriers must provide certification to BellSouth that they are licensed to do business in the area in which they are requesting service. For switch-as-is or switch-with-change orders from CLECs, no additional proof of license will be required. On any order requesting new service, the CLEC must provide a copy of the wireless carrier's license with the order documents.

The procedures described in this guide will be in effect thirty days from the date of this letter.
