Subject CLECs – Update to the BellSouth Products & Services Interval Guide

Effective February 25, 2001, BellSouth will improve the due date intervals for Non-Complex Port/Loop (UNE-P) residence/business combination orders.

The due dates will be reduced from the current intervals of one to seven days to the new intervals of zero to one day.

In consideration of CLEC UNE-P order activity and the non-requirement of dispatch activity, BellSouth is implementing the following changes that pertain to ReqTyp M (Port/Loop Combinations), TCIF 9, for the following Account Level Activity only:

- ACT V full conversion of service to a new Local Service Provider (LSP) as specified.
- ACT W full conversion of service to a new LSP as is.
- ACT P partial migration – initial.
- ACT C change or modification to an existing account.

The new due date intervals will be reflected in an update to the BellSouth Product and Service Interval Guide. The guide will be posted to the Web on February 23, 2001, with an effective date of February 25, 2001.
