Subject: CLECs – **REVISED** - Remote Call Forwarding - Additional Access Path Requirements (Originally posted June 26, 2001)

This is to clarify that when submitting a Local Service Order (LSR) for REQ TYP = E, Remote Call Forwarding with the Uniform Service Order Code (USOC) RCF++ or RD5 ++ and the Field Identifier (FID) GSZ is populated with a quantity greater than 1, the Additional Access Path USOC **RCA** is required. The FID GSZ indicates the number of paths and the USOC RCF++ or RD5++ is always the first path.

The Additional Access Path USOC RCA quantity is always minus 1 from the FID GSZ (Group Size) quantity:

Example: If the GSZ is populated with 3; then the RCA quantity is 2

The clarification regarding Additional Access Path will be included in the next Local Exchange Ordering (LEO) Implementation Guide, Volume 2, scheduled to be released on September 28, 2001.
