Carrier Notification letter SN91082469, originally posted June 26, 2001, has been revised. BellSouth has scheduled to make available for resale a new Uniform Service Order Code (USOC), TBODW, allowing CLECs to waive a deposit for **credit-challenged**¹ end users. The appearance of the TBODW USOC will allow the CLEC to block toll calls at no charge to their end users.
