This is to advise that the BellSouth 256 DSL Service is being offered only in the State of Kentucky in response to a Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) Order released on June 29, 2001, in the matter of KY-PSC Case No. 2001-045. Effective November 9, 2001, as detailed in the BellSouth Private Line Services Tariff, Section B7.12, BellSouth 256 DSL Service will be made available for the transport of data-only communications and will provide a point-to-point private line channel between two customer-designated locations through a common Serving Wire Center (SWC) or through a remote SWC, using a BellSouth 256 DSL Service interoffice channel.

The following restrictions apply:

- Month-to-Month only.
- Not a candidate for channelization.
- Multipoint service is not available
- Suspension of Service is not allowed.
- Service inquiries are necessary to determine service availability.
- No additional services can be provisioned on the 256 DSL circuit.
