This is to advise that in accordance with the Georgia Public Service Commission Docket No. 11900-U, BellSouth will provide CLECs with the following information concerning BellSouth remote terminals:

- Address of the remote terminal
- Common Language Location Identification (CLLI) code of the remote terminal
- Carrier serving area of the remote terminal
- Designation of which remote terminals subtend a particular central office
- Telephone number and address of customers who are served by a particular remote terminal

BellSouth will make this information available to CLECs in all nine states based on the terms and conditions outlined in the Remote Site Collocation Attachment of the Interconnection Agreement between the CLEC and BellSouth. If your company desires this information and currently does not have the necessary language in its Interconnection Agreement with BellSouth, please contact your company's BellSouth Interconnection Agreement Negotiator.

BellSouth will provide the information on a first come-first serve basis within 30 calendar days of a CLEC's request and only subject to the following conditions:

- On a CD in the same format as it appears in the BellSouth systems
- For each serving wire center designated by the CLEC, up to a maximum of 30 wire centers for each state per CLEC request per month
- A maximum of 120 wire centers total per month for each state for all CLECs
- Requesting CLEC agrees to pay the costs incurred by BellSouth in providing the information

Requests for the information should be submitted via e-mail through the Regional Collocation Group. BellSouth is working to upgrade the eApplication system to allow future requests to be made via eApplication. The upgrade to the eApplication system is scheduled to be completed in the first quarter 2002. In the meantime, Request Forms are available from the Regional Collocation Group.
