Subject: CLECs - Availability of New Collocation Power Options from a BellSouth Battery Distribution Fuse Board (BDFB)

In response to requests from CLECs for additional collocation power options from BellSouth BDFBs in its central offices, BellSouth has developed new standards.

Effective immediately, BellSouth will make available additional collocation power increments of 70, 80, 90 and 100 amps for redundant power feeds from a BellSouth BDFB in its central offices. CLECs may now request any of these new power increments on an application for collocation submitted to BellSouth. BellSouth's existing procedures and rate structure currently in effect for each state will be applied to each of these new power options.

To place an order for any of these newly available power increments using the BellSouth mechanized application process (e-Application), simply input the desired amperage in Section 7 of the application. A reminder note in this section currently indicates that a maximum of 60 amps is all that is permitted. Please disregard this note and enter the desired amperage (up to a maximum of 100 amps). This reminder will be changed on the next release/upgrade to the system.
