To: Competitive Local Exchange Carriers (CLECs) and Interexchange Carriers (IXCs)

Subject: CLECs and IXCs – Change of Ordering Requirements for Trunk Group Routing Changes on Access Service Requests (ASR)

This is to advise that changes will be implemented in response to requests from CLECs and IXCs regarding ASR field requirements for Trunk Group Routing changes. These changes include, but are not limited to, Alternate Final to Direct Final (AF to DF), Direct Final to Primary High or Intermediate High (DF to PH or IH), etc.

Effective December 15, 2001, in accordance with the Access Service Ordering Guide (ASOG), BellSouth will begin enforcing the ASR ordering requirements for these types of changes. The ASOG should be used for detailing ASR field requirements and usage rules. Below is a list of specific ASR field requirements for these types of changes:

**ICASR Screen**

LTP = FF

QTY = 1

TQ = BY (FG B access)

= DY (FG D access)

= LY (local)

ACT = C

**ICFGB Screen**

CFA = 1<sup>st</sup> CFA of trunk group (Example: 101/T1/1/CLLILOCA/CLLILOCB)

**ICTQ1 Screen**

TGTYP = Requested Trunk Group Routing

The BellSouth Local Interconnection Service Center (LISC) and Interexchange Customer Service Center (ICSC) will place ASRs requesting Trunk Group Routing changes that have incomplete and/or inaccurate information in clarification. The ASR must be supplemented with correct information within ten (10) working days from the initial clarification date or the ASR will be cancelled and processing terminated.
