Subject: CLECs – Updates to the BellSouth Local Exchange Navigation System (LENS) User Guide, Release 10.3

This is to advise that the BellSouth LENS User Guide will be updated to incorporate the following changes effective with the implementation of Release 10.3 on January 5, 2002:

New Installation with No Prior Service

LENS users may validate an address when there is no Regional Street Address Guide (RSAG) match on the supplemental address information.

Letter of Authorization (LOA) for Loop Makeup (LMU) to Support Line Splitting

LMU information will be provided on any request when the necessary authorization is provided.

Mechanization of Line Splitting

CLECs may enter requests for Unbundled Network Elements (UNE) Central Office (CO) Based Line Splitting, a non-designed UNE product consisting of a UNE loop, UNE voice port, and two (2) cross connects originating at a BellSouth CO.

It is recommended that a copy of this letter be placed in your company's current version of the LENS User Guide until the changes are incorporated in the next update of the LENS User Guide.
