Subject: CLECs – Update to BellSouth Business Rules for Local Ordering (BBR-LO), Issue 10.5current

This is to advise that the BBR-LO, Issue 10.5current, will be updated to adjust the Type of Service (TOS) and Inside Wire Jack Quantity (IWJQ) fields. These updates will impact manual Local Service Request (LSR) processing *only*. Attached is a copy of the updated Data Element Dictionary pages available for immediate use.

These updates will appear in the next update of the BBR-LO, Issue 10.5current, which is scheduled to be posted to the BellSouth Interconnection Services' Web site on Friday, May 24, 2002.

Type of Service (TOS)

Identifies the type of service for the line ordered. The type of service identifies the end user account as business, residential or government.

VALID ENTRIES:

CONDITIONAL USAGE NOTES: None

BUSINESS RULES:

Rule 1: TOS third character must *not* be F, if REQ TYP = F.

Rule 2: If TOS first character is '2', then the second character must be A, B, H, J, R or hyphen (-).

Rule 3: If TOS first character is '1', '2' or '3', then the second character must *not* be a "C".

Rule 4: If TOS first character is '4', then the second character must be "C".

Rule 5: TOS third character must be " - " (hyphen) if REQ TYP = A, B, or C.

Rule 6: TOS second character must be "D" when REQ TYP = N.

Rule 7: If REQ TYP = P, the 2nd character of the TOS field must be "E".

- Rule 8: When the 2nd character of the TOS field is "E", the 1st character can *not* be 2 or 4 .
- Rule 9: TOS third character must be "F" (Flat Rate) when ordering SynchroNet® service.
- Rule 10: For REQ TYP A, valid TOS entries are 1A-, 1B-, 1R-, 1P-, 2R-, 2P- and 19-.
- Rule 11: When both PBX and DID Trunks are on the same request, the second character of the TOS should be "J".
- Rule 12: For REQ TYP B and C, the TOS field must reflect the service that is *currently* on the BellSouth CSR.
- Rule 13: If REQ TYP = M (for UNE-P Centrex) the 2nd character of the TOS field must be "E" and the 3rd character must be "M".
- Rule 14: When REQ TYP=E (WATS) the 2nd character of TOS is D and the 4th character must be W.
- Rule 15: When REQ TYP=E (TFD) the 2nd character of TOS is D and the 4th character must be S.
- Rule 16: The Fourth Character in this field is only valid on Manually processed LSRs.**
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[LS, LSNP, RS forms]

Inside Wire Jack Quantity (IWJQ)

Indicates the number of jacks requested for inside wiring.

NOTE 1: When multiple lines are terminating in one multi-line jack, the IWJK and IWJQ fields should only be populated for the first line.

NOTE 2: Jacks may be ordered on a line-by-line basis.

VALID ENTRIES: 01 - 99

DATA CHARACTERISTICS: ~~2 numeric characters~~

Manual: Up to 2 numeric characters

Electronic: 2 numeric characters

EXAMPLE:

Manual: 1
01

Electronic: 01

CONDITIONAL USAGE NOTES:

Note 1: Required when the IWJK is populated.

Note 2: Required when the JR (Jack Request) field is " Y ".
