Subject: ICOs - Updates to the E911 Guide

This to advise that beginning June 24, 2002, all ICOs that send their E911 daily updates electronically to BellSouth and Intrado, the E911 data vendor, will receive their error reports electronically. The error reports will be delivered to the ICO's Intrado Connect Mailbox instead of being faxed.

In order to support the transition from manually faxed error reports to electronic reports, ICOs will receive both faxed and electronic error reports simultaneously for the first two weeks. After the two-week transition period, ICOs will be responsible for downloading the electronic error reports and, of course, correcting their errors in a timely manner.

This change will also allow the ICOs the option of correcting their errors electronically instead of faxing marked prints to Intrado for manual handling.
