Subject: All BellSouth Interconnection Customers - BellSouth Fatal Edit for Channelized DS3s and DS1s for Managed Shared Network Service (MSNS)

This is to advise that on Friday, July 26, 2002, BellSouth will implement a new fatal edit for Access Service Requests (ASR). The fatal edit will apply to any new ASR for MSNS subscribers for channelized DS1 and DS3 services. The fatal edit will disallow orders for these services unless the Access Customer Terminal Location (ACTL) Common Language Location Identification (CLLI) matches the Secondary Location (SECLOC) CLLI Serving Wire Center. The Local Serving Office (LSO) of the ACTL (A location) and the LSO of the SECLOC (Z location) must be identical. If the fields are not populated in this manner, the returned message will read:

**ICS8111E FATAL EDIT: ACTL CLLI MUST MATCH SECLOC SWC**

Please ensure that personnel within your company who have Service Order responsibility are made aware of this change.
