Subject: CLECs - **REVISED** - Populating Line Class Service (LNECLS SVC) Field for Unbundled Network Element Platform (UNE-P) on the Port Service Form (Originally Posted September 19, 2002).

This is to clarify the use of the LNECLS SVC field on the Post Service Form. The LNECLS SVC field is only required to be populated with a valid Line Class of Service Universal Service Order Code (USOC) when **the following occur**:

- **Activity Type (ACTTYP) = C,**
- **The Line Number Activity (LNA) =C and;**
- **The request is to change the LNECLS SVC or the LNA = N or T,**
- **The LNA = N or T.**

When the LNA does not = N, T or C, there are several options:

1. The LNECLS SVC field with a valid Line Class of Service USOC may be populated.
2. You may leave the LNECLS SVC field blank and BellSouth will derive the Line Class of Service USOC.
3. If a Field Identifier (FID) to an existing line is to be added, the LNECLS SVC field and the feature detail field should both be populated.

Note 1: The Line Class of service USOC should only be populated in the Feature Detail field when it is followed by a valid FID example:

UEPRL/RCU TWC

**Note 2: At this time, Local Exchange Navigation System ( LENS) users changing the Line Class of Service REQ TYP M, ACT TYP C, LNA C should submit the request manually.**
