Subject: Line Information Data Base (LIDB) – Originating Line Number Screening and GetData Query Services

BellSouth is pleased to announce the implementation of two new BellSouth LIDB query services, Originating Line Number Screening (OLNS) and GetData on November 1, 2002. These new query services will be offered via Section 19 of the BellSouth Access Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, to provide telecommunications service providers with access to LIDB subscriber line data that may be used for call processing, validation, billing and fraud prevention. OLNS and GetData will query BellSouth end user data and, where authorized, other carriers' end user data.

**Originating Line Number Screening Query Service**

This query service will provide access to originating line information in LIDB that can be used to facilitate call processing and billing associated with the line from which the call originates. In an OLNS query response, BellSouth will provide screening information residing in LIDB on billing and service restrictions, originating station type, call handling indicators and the account owner associated with the originating line.

**GetData Query Service**

This query service will provide flexible access to LIDB data to validate the Account Owner and/or Regional Accounting Office (RAO) indicating where to send billing records for settlement processes on a local exchange line.

Common transport connectivity to the LIDB database is a prerequisite to ordering OLNS or GetData. The subscriber must have dedicated Signaling System 7 (SS7) links that originate at the subscriber's Facility Single Point of Interface (FSPOI) that terminate at the Gateway Signal Transfer Point(s) (STP). The subscriber must order access ports that provide a dedicated point of interface connection to each of the subscriber's facilities with the Gateway STP(s).
