Subject: CLECs – (Interconnection/Contractual) – **REVISED – Provisioning of Service for 2-Wire Analog Residential Unbundled Network Elements–Platform (UNE-P) and DS0 Wholesale Local Platform Services at BellSouth QuickServ Locations (Latest revision posted on October 8, 2004)**

This is to advise that on November 20, 2004, BellSouth's ordering system will be updated with the capability to apply a new Uniform Service Order Code (USOC) of URECC to orders at end user locations served by QuickServ. **The CLEC should not populate this USOC on the order as the BellSouth ordering system will handle the population automatically for QuickServ equipped lines. The CLEC will place orders for new service with an activity type of N, the same as today.** Beginning November 20, 2004, BellSouth will begin applying the contracted rate for new installations on lines that are not QuickServ equipped.

During the month of October 2004, BellSouth **sent** contract amendments to all CLECs that currently have in-service UNE-P or DS0 Wholesale Local Platform Services. CLECs that do not currently have in-service UNE-P or DS0 Wholesale Local Platform Services must contact their BellSouth contract negotiator to request an amendment **to their Interconnection Agreement.**

By December 15, 2004, CLECs must amend their Interconnection Agreements, Market-Based Rate Agreements and DS0 Wholesale Local Platform Services Agreements to include the new USOC of URECC, which will work in conjunction with Residential 2-Wire Analog UNE-P and DS0 Wholesale Local Platform services. As explained in **an earlier version of this letter**, BellSouth made a policy decision to treat orders for **new 2-wire Analog UNE-P service** at residential end user locations served by QuickServ as "currently combined" conversions of service **instead of** "not currently combined" requests for service, **causing the ordering CLEC to incur a "switch-as-is" nonrecurring charge rather than the higher nonrecurring charge for new service installation.** The "currently combined" conversion rate shall apply in this case to the initial single line **that is equipped with QuickServ**, so long as the service requested is a simple 2-Wire Analog UNE-P service for a residential end user. In the past, BellSouth applied the currently combined nonrecurring charge to all requests for Residential 2-wire Analog UNE-P service, regardless of QuickServ status.

On January 15, 2005, the BellSouth ordering system will begin returning for clarification orders that request service at end user locations served by QuickServ if the USOC URECC is not contained in the CLECs Interconnection Agreement.
