Subject: CLECs – New Multi-Line Uniform Service Order Codes (USOC) For Business Customers in the State of Louisiana

This is to advise that beginning January 18, 2003, new Multi-line USOCs will be implemented in the state of Louisiana. All business customers having more than one line that is identified by having a 9ZR USOC, with 1FB, 1FBCL, 7FB, 7FBCL and OFB Class of Service, will have the new Multi-line USOCs. Existing business customers with the USOCs listed below will be converted to the new USOCs on January 18, 2003.

CLASS OF SERVICE	NEW LINE USOC	DESCRIPTION
1FB	MFB	Business Flat-Rate Multiline
1FBCL	MFBCL	Business Flat-Rate Multiline with Caller ID
7FB	7MB	Business Flat-Rate Multiline-Incoming Only
7FBCL	7MBCL	Business Flat-Rate Multiline-Incoming Only with Caller ID
OFB	YMB	Business Flat-Rate Multiline-Outgoing Only

Effective January 18, 2003, all new orders must use these new USOCs.

This change does not apply to the following:

CUSTOMER TYPES

- Single Line Business Customers
- Multi-line Business Customers who have the following types of service;
 - Business Plus, Option 1 or 2 (BD1, BD1CL, BD2, BD2CL)
 - Complete Choice for Business Package**Note:** Lines inside the packages will not be affected; however, lines outside the package on the same account will require the Business Flat Rate Multi-line USOC

- Back-UP Lines (SBL++)
- Measured Rate Lines (1MG & 1MH)
- Message Rate Lines (1MB)
- Extended Area Calling Plans
- Foreign Exchange (FX)
- Foreign Central Office (FCO)
