Subject: All Telecommunications Carriers - Billing Option Change to a Multiple Bill Arrangement for Tritel Communications, Inc and Telecorp Communications in Alabama, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi and Tennessee, now known as AT&T Wireless Service, Inc.

This is to advise that AT&T Wireless Services, Inc. has acquired Tritel Communications, Inc. and Telecorp Communications in the states of Alabama, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi and Tennessee. An expanded billing arrangement is being implemented between BellSouth and AT&T Wireless Services, Inc. for wireless operations previously owned and operated by Tritel Communications, Inc and Telecorp Communications in the states of Alabama, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi and Tennessee. This new arrangement is known as multiple billing, and is associated with Tandem Level Type 2A and Type 2D Wireless Interconnections.

Multiple billing occurs when subscribers of one telecommunications carrier, either a Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC), Commercial Mobile Radio Service (CMRS) Provider, Independent Company (ICO) or Interexchange Carrier (IXC), terminate traffic to subscribers of another telecommunications carrier through a third telecommunications carrier's network. In this environment, each telecommunications carrier may bill the Originating Carrier for its portion of the telecommunications services (multiple bill) to terminate the call. The Multiple Exchange Carrier Access Billing (MECAB) document, prepared by the Ordering and Billing Forum (OBF), establishes the guidelines for billing when multiple telecommunications carriers are involved in providing telecommunications service.

Effective with switched access usage and/or telecommunications traffic generated beginning August 4, 2003, the billing option for Tritel Communications, Inc and Telecorp Communications now known as AT&T Wireless Service, Inc. will be changed to a multiple bill arrangement.
