Subject: CLECs – (Documentation/Guides) – Updates to the High Frequency Spectrum Unbundled Loop Modification (ULM) CLEC Information Package, Version 4, and the Unbundled Sub-Loop Distribution (USL-D) CLEC Information Package, Version 1

This is to advise that effective January 15, 2004, the High Frequency Spectrum ULM CLEC Information Package, Version 4, and the USL-D CLEC Information Package, Version 1, will be updated with the latest ULM information and references. Additionally, the USL-D package will replace the BellSouth Unbundled Sub-Loop-Intra-Building Network Cable (USL-INC) Voice Grade Distribution Facilities (also known as Riser Cable) CLEC Package, Version 2; and the BellSouth Unbundled Sub-Loop Distribution (USL-D) Voice Grade Distribution Facilities CLEC Package, Version 2.

As information, the new ULM for Copper Loops CLEC Information Package, Version 1, was announced in **Carrier Notification Letter SN91083909** on December 12, 2003. This package will replace the ULM CLEC Information Package, Version 6.

The new ULM package is based on Loop Conditioning as defined by the Federal Communication Commission's (FCC) Triennial Review Order (TRO). This package also included the specific conditions under which BellSouth will remove Bridged Tap (BT).

The CLECs packages noted above will be available on January 15, 2004, on the BellSouth Interconnection Services' Web site at:
