Subject: CLECs – (Documentation/Guides) – **REVISED** - Update to the BellSouth Local Ordering Handbook (LOH) Version **13d** for Telecommunications Industry Forum 9 (TCIF 9) Release 13.0 (Originally posted February 18, 2004)

This is to advise that BellSouth has identified the following documentation defects in the LOH Version **13.0d** for TCIF 9 Release 13.0.

CCP Number	Description Of The Change
1629	<p>Correct LOH Data Dictionary, for TCIF9 and ELMS6: Add “N” to manual data characteristics, so that when the listed number is not known, and will be assigned by the LCSC, the customer can still order a listing for the new telephone number.</p> <p>1st Update Data Characteristics to allow for “10 numeric or 1 alpha” to align with the Example.</p> <p>2nd UPDATE: Add valid entry indicating “N” is the only valid ‘alpha’ character (for this field). ie: “N or numerics”</p>
1644	<p>Updated the Partial Move Process Documentation because, it did not indicate that the process is electronic</p>
1689	<p>The following updates were made:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Change SAN and ORD fields too: Not supported in this practice on the RS and PS data dictionary pages for TCIF 9 and ELMS 6. 2. Change PULSE, SGNL, SSIG and CFA too: Not supported on the RS data dictionary pages for TCIF 9. 3. Change PULSE, CFA, CNAM too: Not supported on the RS form for ELMS 6.

Please refer to the attachments for specific details of the changes listed above.

These changes will be reflected in the next update of the TCIF9 Release 13.0/LOH Version **13.0e** scheduled to be posted March 15, 2004.

Changes for TCIF9 LOH Data Dictionary, LTN Field:

LTN - Listing Telephone Number

Definition Indicates the telephone number to be placed in the directory and quoted in Directory Assistance (DA) as appropriate based on LTY, RTY, and STYC field entries.

Def Notes None

Valid Entries None

VE Notes **None**

N or numerics

Data Charact Manual: 10 numeric characters (excluding optional hyphens) **or**
1 alpha
Electronic: 10 numeric characters

Examples Manual: 2019813500 or 201-981-3500 **or N**
Electronic: 2019813500

CU Notes Note 1: Prohibited when the RTY data is FCR, or LCR.

Note 2: When the RTY data is not FCR, LCR, or LSP, the LTN is required, if LACT = N, D, I or Z..

Bus Rules Rule 1: When the NSTN field on the DL form/screen is a stylist number, the numeric equivalent is required in this field.

Rule 2: When valid entry of " Z " is indicated in the LACT field on the DL form/screen, the telephone number in the LTN field on the DL form/screen must have an identical telephone number on one of the following forms/screens:

Form/Screen.....Field
Number Portability (NP).....Ported #
Loop Service w/Number Portability (LSNP).....Ported #
Resale:.....TNS

CCP 1644 Attachment Listed Below**Partial Move Order Request - REQ TYP E & M, Non-complex****Description**

A partial move request occurs when a customer is requesting to move lines from an existing account at one location to a new location, but wishes to leave at least one (1) working line at the old location.

Restrictions

- Not applicable to remote call forwarding
- Dual service is not applicable

Ordering Considerations

The customer must submit multiple LSR packages and use the RPON and NOR fields to associate the LSRs.

- The first LSR should be submitted with an ACT C, LNA D for all lines that are moving to the new location, or are simply being disconnected at the time of the move.
- The second LSR should be submitted with an ACT N, LNA N for all lines that are being installed at the new service address. Additional lines (that did not exist at the previous address) may also be added on this LSR using LNA N.
- The RPON field should be populated with the PON from the lead LSR, on **all** LSRs involved with the partial move request.
- The NOR field, for the lead PON, must be 01-XX, where XX is equal to the total number of LSRs involved with the partial move request. Each subsequent value for this field must be increased by one digit with XX data remaining the same.
- The customer should follow the REQ TYP E (NON-Complex) R/C/O tables for ACT of C and ACT of N for completing an LSR for a partial move order on a resale account.
- The customer should follow the REQ TYP M (Non-Complex) R/C/O tables for ACT of C and ACT of N for completing an LSR for a partial move order on Port/Loop combination residence/business.
- When either ACT of N or C indicates manual ordering only, both LSR's must be submitted manually.
