Subject: Facility-Based CLECs – (E911 and Product/Service) - BellSouth® 911 Private Branch Exchange (PBX) Locate Service

This is to advise that on September 30, 2004, BellSouth will introduce BellSouth® 911 PBX Locate Service, a new product offering. This service provides wholesale customers the ability to offer E911 service to their PBX customers that identifies to the Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) the actual physical location and the station telephone number of the PBX 911 caller.

BellSouth® 911 PBX Locate Service has a transport component and a database component. The transport component, PBX Locate Transport Channel, provides a dedicated trunk path from a PBX switch to a 911 tandem office for delivery of 911 calls to the appropriate 911 PSAP. The database component, PBX Locate Database Capability, provides the capability of storing corresponding PBX station telephone number and location information into the Automatic Location Identification (ALI) database.

This service is offered to all BellSouth wholesale customers where facilities are available and pursuant to the rates, terms and conditions in the applicable Interconnection Agreement. Customers should contact their BellSouth local support manager regarding any pre-ordering questions applicable to this service.

The general technical requirements for this service can be found in Technical Reference (TR) 73576. The TR is available on the BellSouth Interconnection Services Web site in total at:

The TR describes network interface specifications, transmission channel information, transmission performance parameters supported, and interface and signaling protocol requirements.

Once an amendment to the Interconnection Agreement has been executed to provide for the service, customers may request it by completing the required service request forms and submitting them to the Complex Resale Support Group (CRSG). The forms required are listed in the BellSouth® 911 PBX Locate Service CLEC Information Package along with the associated Web site address for the forms.
