Subject: All Telecommunications Carriers – (E911) - Conversion of BellSouth's Emergency Service (ES) Trunks from Multi-Frequency (MF) Signaling to Common Channel Signaling 7 (CCS7) in Georgia Only

This is to advise that starting September 30, 2004, BellSouth will begin the conversion of its BellSouth end office E911 trunks from MF signaling to CCS7 signaling in Georgia with a target completion date of September 5, 2005. No action is required by Carriers for this conversion.

Based on the need to provide and maintain the reliability and integrity of E911 service as communications technologies and regulatory environments change, BellSouth now offers an additional industry standard signaling option for its E911 service by supporting the use of Signaling System 7/Integrated Digital Network User Part (SS7/ISUP) signaling for incoming E911 calls. Carriers interested in converting their E911 ES trunks to CCS7 may contact their BellSouth account team representative.
