REVISED - Enhancements to BellSouth® Wavelength Dedicated Ring Service and
BellSouth® Wavelength Channel Service Dedicated System to add new Wavelength
Channels (Originally posted on November 28, 2006)

This is to advise that, on **December 29**, 2006, the BellSouth Tariff FCC No.1, Section 29, will become effective. This tariff enhancement will broaden the existing BellSouth® Wavelength Dedicated Ring Service and BellSouth® Wavelength Channel Service Dedicated System to include the following new Wavelength Channels:

Bit Rate Specific:

- OC-3 Transport with Transparent Overhead Wavelength Channel
- OC-12 Transport with Transparent Overhead Wavelength Channel
- OC-48 Transport with Transparent Overhead Wavelength Channel
- Fast Ethernet at 100 Mbps Transport Wavelength Channel
- Fibre Channel 100 Transport Wavelength Channel
- Fibre Channel 200 Transport Wavelength Channel
- Fibre Connection (FICON™) Channel Transport Wavelength Channel
- Fibre Connection (FICON™) Express Channel Transport Wavelength Channel
- ESCON™ / SBCON Channel Transport Wavelength Channel
- 10 Gbps LAN Transport Wavelength Channel

With the exception of the 10 Gbps LAN Transport Wavelength Channel, the Wavelength Channels listed above will be link connectable to BellSouth® Interoffice Wavelength Channel and individual Wavelength Channels. The 10 Gbps LAN Transport Wavelength Channel link connection capabilities will be limited to connections between the BellSouth Wavelength Dedicated Ring and BellSouth Wavelength Channel Service Dedicated System.

These Wavelength Channels can be ordered unprotected, with Client Protection capability and with Optical Network Protection.

Ordering and implementation may begin on the tariff effective date. The Carrier Access Billing System (CABS) will render billing in the same manner in which existing bills are rendered today. In addition, the CABS bill will reflect the appropriate Uniform Service Order Code (USOC) for the services ordered.
