Subject: CLECs – (Billing and Product/Service) – **REVISED** - Implement Billing of Cancellation Charges for Cancelled Electronic Local Service Requests (originally posted January 17, 2007)

Effective February 20, 2007, BellSouth will begin billing Competitive Local Exchange Carriers (CLEC) for electronic Local Service Requests (LSR) that are cancelled at the end user/CLEC's request, or when a CLEC fails to respond to a customer caused missed appointment jeopardy notification. **In addition, BellSouth will also bill a one time cancellation charge for cancelled LSRs that were not previously billed during the 12-month period from February 20, 2006 through February 19, 2007. It is anticipated that these charges will appear on the CLEC bills prior to May 1, 2007.**

BellSouth is currently billing cancellation charges for manually issued and manually canceled LSRs. BellSouth will bill CLECs in accordance with the rates, terms and conditions in their Interconnection Agreement, Commercial Agreement or Resale Agreement.

The cancellation charges will bill at the Uniform Service Order Code (USOC) level and will appear in the Other Charges and Credits (OC&C) section of the bill. **For the purpose of billing the one time cancellation charge, the reference number shown on the bill will be the CLEC's Purchase Order Number (PON) for the cancelled LSR.**
