On July 27, 2007, the AT&T Southeast Region will enhance the BellSouth Tariff FCC No. 1, Section 29. This enhancement will broaden the existing High Capacity (a/k/a SPA High Capacity) service and Self-healing Multi-nodal Alternate Route Topology Ring (SMARTRing®) service (a/k/a SPA Dedicated Ring) to include the following new customer and central office channel interfaces:

The new central office service interfaces are link connectable between High Capacity and Self-healing Multi-nodal Alternate Route Topology Ring (SMARTRing) services. These interfaces are not available in conjunction with service configurations that incorporate an optical customer termination or an optical serving wire center termination.

Ordering and implementation may begin on the tariff effective date. Carrier Access Billing System (CABS) bills will be rendered in the same manner in which existing bills are rendered today. In addition, the CABS bill will reflect the appropriate Uniform Service Order Code (USOC) for the services ordered.
