On June 29, 2007, the Unbundled Network Element (UNE) to Special Access (SPA) Conversion Process Information Package Version 3 will update to Version 4. This update will include a new spreadsheet process that will allow a facility-based CLEC to send the UNE to SPA conversion spreadsheet to the account manager rather than to the CLEC Care group.

Additionally, this update will include the name change from BellSouth to AT&T.
