January 2004 performance results for SBC Midwest performance measurements are now available.

Business Rules:

The SBC/Ameritech Performance Measurements User Guide Version 1.8, the colorlined Version 1.9 and the 2002 Six-Month Review Agreed-To Measurement Change Implementation Schedule are available in the Historical Business Rules section. Please note:

- Per the agreement reached in the Billing PM Collaborative conducted March-July 2003, PM 125 Percent Matching UNE-P Provisioning and Billing DB Records has been implemented with January 2004 results.
- The criteria for PM70 has been enhanced to separately report the SBC end office to CLEC end office trunks from the SBC tandem to CLEC end office trunks.
- The web display for PM 47 has been updated to correct the label on the disaggregation "% SBC/Ameritech Missed DDs (>90 Days)-No Facilities-Design-UNE Loop & Port-Other Combinations". The disaggregation had been incorrectly labeled "% SBC/Ameritech Missed DDs (>30 Days)-No Facilities-Design-UNE Loop & Port-Other Combinations". The published results properly reported performance for the ">90 Days" disaggregation.
- The State Performance Measurements results display available on this site is being modified to provide a more consistent and informative display of information. The column label for the field containing SBC Retail results data has been updated to reflect the column heading as "Retail" for all PMs. In addition, a column has been added labeled "Z-Value Comparison". This column will identify which SBC result (Retail or Affiliate-see Note) was used for the z-value calculation. The non-State Performance Measurement result displays will be transitioned in future months.

NOTE: With this change the affiliate results will only appear in the column labeled "Affiliate". In the past the affiliate results were replicated in the Retail column when there was no Retail result and the affiliate data was used for generation of the z-value. The exceptions to this change with the current display are DSL and Broadband DSL line sharing disaggregations of PMs 55, 55.3, 56, 58-63, 65-67 and 69 as well as PMs 1.1, 1.3, MI 4, MI 10 and MI 16. The affiliate results are also reported in the Retail column. SBC Midwest is working to address this issue and will provide notification via this web page when this enhancement is completed.
