- The DSL Loops No Line Sharing disaggregation benchmark for ST 61 has been edited to reflect 6.5 days.
- Effective with May 2003 results, the calculation of the numerator for PM 114 has been updated to count as misses only orders with a SBC jeopardy code in the "S" jeopardy code position of the Cut String and to count as premature any cut that occurs 10 or more minutes prior to the time the CLEC calls, to address BearingPoint Observations 815 and 631.
