Business Rules:

The SBC/Ameritech Performance Measurements User Guide Version 1.8 and the color-lined Version 1.9 have been moved to the Historical Business Rules section. SBC/Ameritech has identified a number of conflicts within the SBC/Ameritech Performance Measurement User Guide Version 1.9. The matrix outlining these know/identified business rules conflicts will be updated as needed and is located at <u>Conflict Matrix</u>. SBC Midwest expects to address these conflicts in the next six-month review collaborative.

The 2002 Six-Month Review Agreed-To Measurement Change Implementation Schedule indicates the results posting date that the changes were implemented and is located at <u>Six</u> month schedule.

Recalculated and Reposted Performance Measures:

Listed below are the measures for which previously reported results have been recalculated and reposted on July 7, 2003. SBC Ameritech makes available a listing of the recalculated and reposted performance measurement results that have also been restated (changed from the originally posted result) in the Reports section of this website. These reports are available for both CLEC-aggregate results and CLEC-specific results, and are accessed in the same manner as existing performance measurement reports.

- PM 17 has been recalculated and reposted for January through April 2003 to incorporate revised criteria logic ensuring that results for all order types are

calculated consistently. This revision enhances the determination of on-time or late posting to billing.

Please note:

- New PMs 35.1, 124 and 124.1 were implemented with April 2003 results posted on May 20, 2003. However, these PMs were inadvertently omitted from the drop down selection list on the Performance Measurement Results selection window. These PMs have been added to the list and can be specifically selected. The inability to specifically select these PM results for display had no affect on results reported.
- The result titles for CLEC WI 11 have been edited to reflect the requirements of the Business Rules.
- The DSL Loops No Line Sharing disaggregation benchmark for ST 61 has been edited to reflect 6.5 days as specified in the business rule.
